Declaration: Compensation for EU foreign policy related sanctions

Whereas:

- The European Union Common Foreign and Security Policy sometimes brings about sanctions and corresponding retaliation to and from non-EU States which negatively affect mostly (although not solely) international trade.

Considering that:

- European workers and business are not responsible for the international disputes that give way to sanctions although they directly suffer their negative effects in entire sectors of the economy, causing job and money losses and even business bankruptcy
- The EU Foreign and Security decision-making process is one of the most undemocratic and untransparent of our democratically improvable Union

The European Free Alliance

1. Demands that immediate and sufficient redress and compensation must be made available as a general obligation to those directly affected by sanctions linked to EU Foreign and Security policies.
2. Demands that budget provisions and a common EU scheme be set up in order to cope with such an obligation.
