Motion: Situation in Palestine

Recalling the motion on the Palestine situation passed by the Ajaccio's General Assembly in 2016,

Recalling that the occupation of the West Bank is 50 years old in June, and shows no sign of ending,

Recalling the "two-state solution" agreed in outline by Israelis and Palestinians at Oslo in 1993,

- A. The European Free Alliance is most concerned about the pace at which the occupation policy is progressing. In February 2017 only, the Government of Israel has authorized the building of 6.000 new homes in existing settlements in the West Bank and in East Jerusalem.
- B. Deeply concerned by the new law approved on February 6, 2017 at the Knesset which the facto makes legal the settlements previously built on private Palestinian property.
- C. Deeply concerned because the two-state solution is rapidly moving further away,

The European Free Alliance,

- 1. Supports the UN 2334 resolution adopted by the Security Council on December 23, 2016.
- 2. Requires the United Nations to demand compliance with the 2334 (2016) resolution.
- 3. Requires the EU Institutions and in particular the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy to make all the possible diplomatic efforts aimed at achieving without delay, a comprehensive, just and lasting peace in the Middle East.
- 4. Requires the EU States to promote bilateral and multilateral dialogue in that same sense.
- 5. Supports the efforts made by the Palestinian representatives to try to form a new Unity Government, including the holding of free and democratic elections in the West Bank and Gaza Strip.
