Motion: Future relations with EFA parties in the UK

A. Having regard to the United Kingdom's referendum vote to leave the European Union on the 23rd of June 2016,

The European Free Alliance,

1. Reaffirms that EFA parties in the UK retain full membership of EFA, if they so wish;
2. Restates its commitment to those in the UK working for a "Europe of the Peoples";
3. Recognises the need for renewed efforts to create a democratic and effective European Union which values diversity and practises equality;
4. Believes that, despite Wales' narrow vote to leave the EU, EFA should stand side-by-side with Plaid Cymru, which remains committed as the party of Wales to its aim of achieving independence for Wales in Europe;
