Title (of the Motion/Declaration)	Situation in Palestine
<p>Taking into account the occupation policy carried out in Palestine by the Government of Israel, the discriminatory restrictions on human rights including the killing and the arbitrary detention of children, the restriction of movement of people and goods into and out of Gaza Strip, the damages to the civilian population in the Gaza protests, the unlawful transfer of Israeli citizens to settlements and the destruction of houses of Palestinians in the occupied West Bank;</p> <p>The European Free Alliance</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Requests the Israeli authorities to end all settlement activity and to dismantle all the outposts erected. 2. Requests the Government of Israel to put an end to all evictions, demolitions, and the confiscation of Palestinian goods and land. 3. Calls on the Israeli Government to end the closure of Gaza and allow for the reconstruction of housing units and infrastructure such as health and energy facilities, water supplies etc. 4. Calls the respect for the NGOs working in Palestine. 5. Recommends the inclusion of Human Rights clauses in the contracts established with Israel and requests the EU member States to put into practice the new labeling policy established by the EU on settlement goods and services. 6. Calls to abolish the Nation State Law, a law with constitutional status that articulates for Jews alone the right of self-determination, makes it a national priority to build homes for Jews but not others, and that revokes the status of Arabic as an official language of Israel. EFA critic the Israeli authorities 	

by continuing to narrow the space for criticism of its police toward Palestinians, denying entry into Israel of foreign nationals critical of Israeli police.

7. Calls the European Union to encourage USA Administration to revoke the decision to move its embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem and call to revoke its decision of cut all funding to the United Nations Reliefs and Work Agency (UNRWA) which provides critical services, including education and health care, to children in the West Bank and Gaza.

8. Supports a renewed multilateral approach to the peace process according to the international law.
