<b>Name of the person introducing the Motion to the GA</b>	
<b>Member party</b>	Femu a Corsica
<b>Title [of the Motion]</b>	Justice and truth for Yvan Colonna and a political solution for Corsica
<p>Considering:</p> <p>a) That Yvan Colonna, a Corsican patriot, was murdered in disturbing conditions at the Arles remand centre on 2 March 2022 by a jihadist;</p> <p>b) That successive governments have for years been practicing a policy of State vengeance that does not respect the Law, concerning the prisoners of the Erignac commando: Pierre Alessandri, Alain Ferrandi and Yvan Colonna;</p> <p>c) That if the law had been applied and the status of particularly guarded detainee abolished, Yvan Colonna would have been brought closer to Corsica to the prison of Borgu and would not have been assassinated;</p> <p>d) That the security conditions were not ensured by the State prison administration in a central yet dedicated to the management of so-called DPS prisoners;</p> <p>e) That this has generated popular emotion and a very significant feeling of injustice among the Corsican people who, under the impetus of the youth, massively demonstrated in the streets of Corti and Bastia;</p> <p>f) That this feeling of injustice has been fuelled by the State's denial of democracy since 2015, which has not taken into account the successive victories at each election, the most recent of which being the territorial elections of June 2021, in which 68% of Corsicans voted for autonomist and separatist lists, including 41% for the Fà Populu Inseme list led by Gilles Simeoni and supported by Femu a Corsica;</p> <p>g) That since 2015, the vast majority of Corsicans have affirmed their desire for a global political solution based on full and full autonomy;</p> <p>h) That this has created a climate of tensions, fractures and violence in Corsica, which has been present for many years;</p> <p>i) That the State, faced with this situation, has implemented the rapprochement of Alain Ferrandi and Pierre Alessandri and has opened a discussion of historic significance for a global political solution for Corsica with the President of the Executive, Gilles Simeoni;</p>	

j) That the State cancelled the 1st meeting of this historic negotiation on the pretext of an unstable climate.

The European Free Alliance:

- 1) Supports the Colonna family in this painful ordeal;
- 2) Affirms that justice and truth must be served for Yvan Colonna;
- 3) Denounces the policy of the State concerning the management of political prisoners which partly caused this tragedy;
- 4) Denounces the denial of democracy by successive governments since 2015;
- 5) Asks for the resumption of a historical discussion between Corsica and the French State for a global political solution based on a status of full autonomy and full exercise allowing the Corsican people to control their destiny in their land;
- 6) Affirms that only dialogue on a global political solution for Corsica and its people will allow for the lasting establishment of peace.
