Title [of the Motion]	For a self-determination vote in Corsica
<p>For a self-determination vote in Corsica</p> <p>Considering that Corsica is an island with a distinct people, history, and culture in Europe with its own language, traditions, and institutions;</p> <p>Considering that the right to self-determination is a fundamental principle recognized by the United Nations Charter and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights;</p> <p>Considering that the Corsican people have the right to be recognized as such, to benefit from a full autonomy status to be able to decide on their own future, and to have their language and culture respected and protected;</p> <p>Considering the various electoral victories of autonomist and independence parties in the recent Corsican elections, thus testifying to the growing popular support for greater autonomy;</p> <p>Considering the popular mobilization that followed the assassination of Yvan Colonna in Arles in March 2022 and the opening of negotiations with the French government and Corsican representatives;</p> <p>The European Free Alliance emphasizes the need to recognize the Corsican people and to guarantee Corsica a full autonomy status, which would allow the Corsican people to freely decide on their political, economic, and social future. It also calls for the official recognition of the Corsican language.</p> <p>The European Free Alliance requests that the ongoing negotiations between the French government and Corsican elected officials lead to a self-determination vote for the Corsican people. This vote should be organized in accordance with democratic and international principles.</p> <p>The European Free Alliance supports the right of peoples to decide their own political future and believes that self-determination in Corsica would be in line with the spirit of the United Nations Charter and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.</p>
