For a self-determination vote in Corsica

Considering that Corsica is an island with a distinct people, history, and culture in Europe with its own language, traditions, and institutions;

Considering that the right to self-determination is a fundamental principle recognized by the United Nations Charter and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights;

Considering that the Corsican people have the right to be recognized as such, to benefit from a full autonomy status to be able to decide on their own future, and to have their language and culture respected and protected;

Considering the various electoral victories of autonomist and independence parties in the recent Corsican elections, thus testifying to the growing popular support for greater autonomy;

Considering the popular mobilization that followed the assassination of Yvan Colonna in Arles in March 2022 and the opening of negotiations with the French government and Corsican representatives;

The European Free Alliance emphasizes the need to recognize the Corsican people and to guarantee Corsica a full autonomy status, which would allow the Corsican people to freely decide on their political, economic, and social future. It also calls for the official recognition of the Corsican language.

The European Free Alliance requests that the ongoing negotiations between the French government and Corsican elected officials lead to a self-determination vote for the Corsican people. This vote should be organized in accordance with democratic and international principles.

The European Free Alliance supports the right of peoples to decide their own political future and believes that self-determination in Corsica would be in line with the spirit of the United Nations Charter and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.
