Title [of the Motion]	For a true status of autonomy for CORSICA
<p>Considering :</p> <p>a) That the Corsican people have been leading a legitimate struggle for the recognition of their rights for more than fifty years;</p> <p>b) That since 2015, at each territorial election, the Corsican people have voted by a very large majority in favor of a true status of autonomy for Corsica;</p> <p>c) That however, the legitimate demands expressed by the Corsicans in the search for a dialogue with the State have remained in vain;</p> <p>d) That since the assassination of Yvan Colonna in a French prison on March 2, 2022, and the reactions generated by this tragedy, the State has opened up a channel for discussion;</p> <p>e) That only a true global political solution will allow the completion of a conflict that has lasted for over fifty years in its contemporary period;</p> <p>f) That consequently, Femu A Corsica wishes the inscription of Corsica in the French constitution so that Corsica has a true status of autonomy of full right and full exercise.</p> <p>The European Free Alliance :</p> <p>1) Reaffirms the right of peoples to self-determination and defends the universal values of democracy;</p> <p>2) Supports the right of the Corsican people to autonomy;</p> <p>3) Supports the elected representatives of Corsica in their will to make this process succeed;</p> <p>4) Calls for a global political solution for Corsica;</p> <p>5) Recalls that only the modification of the European treaties giving the regions a real institutional status, will allow to reinforce the economic, social and territorial cohesion of the European Union.</p>
