Title (of the Motion)	Motion to warn against far-right ideologies
<p>Text of the motion: (In English; Maximum 600 words)</p> <p>Motion to warn against far-right ideologies</p> <p>We, the members of the General Assembly of the EFA party, meeting today, express our deep concern about the current rise of far-right ideologies in Europe. These ideologies take advantage of the fragility of our societies, which are facing numerous crises and focus their discourse on security by making immigrants scapegoats; reject diversity on issues of gender identity, sexual orientation, family typologies; have a restricted vision of religion, and a revisionist approach to the history of Europe in the twentieth century; put forward self-centred so-called "national" values by excluding cultural and linguistic minorities, ignoring the rights of peoples and finally are in denial of climate change.</p> <p>Considering:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. That our peoples have the inalienable right to decide their own future, in accordance with the principles of self-determination. 2. That our cultures and languages must be protected, respected, and promoted by European and state policies. 3. That migration policies must be based on respect for human rights and international solidarity. 4. That insecurity today is mainly due to drug trafficking and religious fundamentalism and not to the condition of migrant citizens. 	

We call on our European institutions:

1. That the European Union set up a “cordon sanitaire” against the far right,
2. That it ensure the protection of the fundamental rights of citizens within the Union.
3. That the rights of peoples to decide for themselves be respected and that the Union support peaceful movements for self-determination.
4. That it ensure that any political group that advocates racist or xenophobic theses and comments is sanctioned.
5. That migration policy focus on improving reception, protection of refugees and migrants and development aid policies.
